

Professor Marja-Riitta Taskinen



Marja-Riitta Taskinen is currently Professor of Medicine at the Department of Medicine, Division of Cardiology, University of Helsinki.

Her main interest has been lipid and lipoprotein metabolism, and her long series of original and important observations have contributed significantly to the understanding of lipoprotein abnormalities, genetics and pathophysiology in Type 2 diabetes, insulin resistance and the metabolic syndrome. Prof. Taskinen has been tremendously productive scientifically and she has published more than 300 original publications and 90 reviews and chapters. Her outstanding achievements have been recognised by several international honours and awards including Castelli Pedrolì Prize (EASD 1996), The Hippocrates Prize (2000), the Claude Bernard Award (EASD 2002), the Edwin Bierman Award (ADA 2004) and recently Novartis Award for longstanding achievements in diabetes (EASD 2006). She has been actively involved in activities of EAS and IAS as well as of the EASD and IDF. She was the chairperson for the 1997 IDF Meeting in Helsinki. She is currently President of EAS and a member of International Task Force for Prevention of Coronary Heart Disease.
