Developing guidance for implementing better care of familial hypercholesterolemia

Familial hypercholesterolemia (FH) is a preventable cause of premature coronary artery disease, with major significance for public health. This is underscored by the fact that there are up to 35 million people with FH worldwide of whom less than 10% are currently recognized.

The International Atherosclerosis Society (IAS) has convened a team of experts (The International Expert Working Group) to review the rapidly expanding evidence and to generate a contemporary guidance to implement improved care of FH.

The anticipated final guidance will include evidence-informed clinical recommendations relating to screening, diagnosis, and treatment of FH. Implementation strategies will be based on the ERIC taxonomy, which will guide the development of general and specific implementation recommendations.
